Most of these databases either contain full text articles or link to full text articles.

**ABI/Inform Dateline** – Focuses on hard-to-find local and regional business news coverage.

**ABI/Inform Global** – Business and management database with many full text articles.

**ABI/Inform Trade & Industry** – Indexes business periodical and newsletter articles on major industries.

**Accounting & Tax** – Indexes accounting and tax related articles.

**ACM Digital Library** – Collection of publications from the Association of Computing Machinery.

**AH Citation Search** – Citation and article index for the arts and humanities.

**Alternative Press Index** – Indexes publications in the areas of cultural, social, economic, and political change.

America: History and Life – Indexes scholarly literature on the history of the U.S. and Canada.

**Art Index** – Indexes articles on fine, applied, and decorative arts.

**ArticleFirst** – Indexes articles from journals in all academic disciplines.

**ATLA Religion Database** – Indexes religion and theology journals.

Avery Index to Architectural Periodicals -- Index to the literature of architecture and interior design.

**Banking Information Source** – Indexes publications about the financial services and banking industries.

**Biography and Genealogy Master Index** – Index to biographical sources.

**Biological and Agricultural Index** – Indexes articles in biology, ecology, agriculture, and forestry.

**Books in Print** – Citations for over 2 million books.

**Cambridge Journals Online** – 160 journals published by Cambridge University in all academic disciplines.

**Career and Technical Education** – Indexes publications about adult, career, and vocational education.

**CINAHL** – Index to nursing, allied health, and biomedical literature.

**CJPI Criminal Justice Periodical Index** – Index to criminal justice and law enforcement.

**Collegiate Dictionary** – Online version of Webster's Collegiate Dictionary.

**Computer Database** – Indexes software reviews, product introductions, and news.

**Contemporary Authors** – Biographical information on over 90,000 writers from 1900 to the present.

**Contemporary Literary Criticism** – Critical essays on contemporary writers.

**Contemporary Women's Issues** – Indexes women's health and human rights issues world wide.

**Dictionary of Literary Biography** – Biographical and critical studies on major authors.

**Dissertation Abstracts Online** – Index of U. S. and Canadian doctoral dissertations.

**EBM Reviews:** All – Includes citations from all of the four following Evidence Based Medicine (EBM) Reviews databases.

**EBM Reviews:** American College of Physicians Journal Club – Full text medical reviews.

**EBM Reviews:** Cochrane Controlled Trials Register – Provides references and abstracts of medical trials.

**EBM Reviews:** Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews – Full text medical reviews.

**EBM Reviews: Database of Abstracts of Reviews of Effectiveness** – Expanded abstracts of medical reviews.

**ECO** (**IDEAL**) – Archive from 1996-2002 of the full text of 200 Academic Press journals formerly available through IDEAL.

**EconLit** – Indexes economic literature.

**Encyclopedia Britannica Online** – Full text of articles on many topics with additional features.

Encyclopedia of Associations – Information on U. S. and international associations.

**ERIC** – Comprehensive index to education journals, ERIC documents, and other publications.

**ERIC** (U.S. Department of Education) – U.S. government's web version of its ERIC database.

**Expanded Academic ASAP** – Indexes articles in all academic disciplines.

**Factiva** – Full text articles in business and other subjects as well as in-depth company information.

**FORENSICnetBASE** – Full text of over 70 books on forensic science and criminal justice from CRC Press.

Gale Database of Publications and Broadcast Media – Covers U.S. and Canadian print, TV, and radio.

**HarpWeek** – Image reproductions of issues of Harper's Weekly.

Health Reference Center-Academic – Indexes articles on fitness, nutrition, nursing and medicine.

**Historical Abstracts** – Indexes literature on history of the world since 1450, excluding U. S. and Canada.

Legal Periodicals – Indexes legal journals and law reviews.

**LEXIS-NEXIS Academic Universe** – News, legal, business and medical information; federal and state court cases.

**Literature Resource Center** – Biographies, critical analysis, and bibliographies for authors.

MathSciNet – Covers the world's mathematical literature since 1940

**Media Review Digest** – Reviews educational and entertainment non-print media.

**MEDLINE** – National Library of Medicine index to the international biomedical journal literature.

**MEDLINE In-Process Plus** – Indexes health related literature being processed for inclusion in MEDLINE.

Mental Measurements Yearbook – Electronic version of the Mental Measurements Yearbook.

**MLA International Bibliography** – Indexes books and articles on literature, linguistics and folklore.

**OED Oxford English Dictionary** – Searchable version of the Oxford English Dictionary, 2<sup>nd</sup> edition.

**OldMEDLINE** – Indexes health related literature from 1951-1965.

Oxford Journals Online - Over 130 journals published by Oxford University in all academic disciplines.

**PAIS International** -- Indexes articles, books and documents on government and public policy.

**PAISArchive** – Indexes articles, books and documents on government and public policy from 1915 to 1976.

**Papers First** – Citations to papers presented at conferences.

**Periodical Index** – Indexes magazines and scholarly journals in a variety of subjects from 1983-1993 only.

**Pharmaceutical News Index** – Indexes publications in the pharmaceutical, health care, biotechnology, and medical devices industries.

**Project MUSE** – Over 100 University Press journals, primarily in the humanities and social sciences.

**ProQuest Asian Business** – Asian business and financial information from a variety of international publications.

**ProQuest Computing** – Indexes and includes full text from top computing journals from 1988 to date.

**ProQuest Education Complete – Covers a wide range of topics in education.** 

**ProQuest European Business** – European business and financial information.

**ProQuest Historical Newspapers: New York Times** -- Full text of the entire New York Times from 1857 to 2001.

**ProQuest Nursing Journals** – Articles in nursing and physical therapy, many in full-text.

**ProQuest Religion** – Indexes theological studies and commentary on topics of general interest.

**ProQuest Research Library** – Indexes articles in all academic disciplines.

**ProQuest Science Journals** – Indexes publications in all the physical and life sciences.

**ProQuest Social Science Journals** – Indexes journals in all areas of the social sciences.

**ProQuest Telecommunications** – Indexes articles from major telecommunications industry publications.

**PsycINFO** (1872-1973) – Indexes psychological literature from 1872-1973.

**PsycINFO 1974** – Comprehensive index of psychological literature from 1974.

**PubMed** – Indexes articles in health related fields and in the life sciences.

**RefWorks** – Personal bibliographic software for creating and formatting research papers and bibliographies.

Science Direct – Full text of more than 150 bio-medical journals published by Elsevier.

**Safari Tech Books Online** – Collection of electronic books on computer topics.

**SocioFile** – Indexes publications in sociology and in related subjects.

**SPORTDiscus** – An international index on sport and fitness literature.

**Standard & Poor's NetAdvantage** – Financial and investment information on U.S. stocks, bonds, industries and companies.

**Statistical Universe** – Indexes statistical tables from a variety of producers.

**Ulrich's Periodicals Directory** – Comprehensive information on serials published throughout the world.

**Union Lists** – Library holdings of journals and other serials.

WorldCat – Descriptions of millions of books owned by libraries worldwide.
